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# Vision & Mission Statement

We aim to develop servant leaders who effectively evangelize and disciple across cultures through multi-ethnic, multi-disciplinary learning experiences in both formal and informal settings.

# Program Overview

The Master's Degree in Christian Leadership and Management, with a focus on theological and spiritual studies, is a comprehensive educational program designed to provide students with the knowledge and practical skills essential for effective leadership and management. This program integrates modern management principles with theological studies, enabling graduates to apply this knowledge in their professional and spiritual lives, with a strong emphasis on Christian values and principles.

## Program Design

This program customized for college and university graduates aiming to pursue advanced studies while actively participating in various ministry fields. The primary language of instruction is Arabic, with supplementary educational materials provided in English to enhance comprehension and ensure thorough preparation. Students are expected to produce academic work in Arabic, thereby honing their research, writing skills in the language of study, and enriching the Arabic library with profound theological research content. The program's design fosters the development of independent study skills, including researching materials, participating in seminars, writing research papers, and completing a thesis.

## Program Duration

The online program offers flexibility for students, allowing them to choose between two study formats:

- **Full-Time: Complete the program in 2.5 years.**
- **Part-Time: Finish the program in 3.5 years.**
- **Entry Points:**

Students can begin the program at two times during the year:

January

September

Each module spans 3 months, during which students are expected to enroll in 4 courses.

# Program Objective

This program aims to develop well-rounded leaders by integrating leadership, management, and theological principles with Christian values in professional and personal life.

## **1. Leadership and Management Development**

- Learn modern leadership and management theories and methods.
- Apply effective problem-solving and decision-making strategies.
- Strengthen communication skills and team-building capabilities.
- Lead teams and manage projects efficiently and effectively.

## **2. Theological and Spiritual Growth**

- Study and interpret Christian sacred texts.
- Gain a deep understanding of fundamental Christian doctrines and apply them in daily life.
- Enhance spiritual growth and ethical decision-making through reflection and prayer.

## **3. Faith-Based Ethical Leadership**

- Integrate Christian principles into administrative and professional work.
- Foster integrity, transparency, and social responsibility in leadership.
- Cultivate an organizational culture based on respect, equality, and ethical values.
- Maintain a balanced approach to faith and work, ensuring alignment between personal beliefs and professional responsibilities.

# Program Components

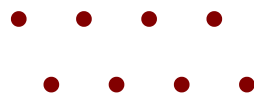
The Master's program consists of 60 academic credits under the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS), divided into five parts:

# Educational Objectives



- **Effective Leadership and Management:** Ability to lead teams and manage projects efficiently.
- **Deep Theological Understanding:** Comprehensive knowledge of Christian theological and spiritual concepts.
- **Work-Faith Balance:** Integration of Christian values into both professional and personal life.

## Who this degree is for

- Individuals seeking to develop leadership and management skills while enhancing their theological understanding and faith.
- Religious leaders aiming to improve their administrative abilities and apply spiritual principles to serve their communities.
- Professionals working in nonprofit or religious organizations who wish to enhance their managerial and spiritual effectiveness.

## Teaching Methods

- **Self-Study:** Learners can choose study times that fit their schedules.
- **Interactive Lectures:** Educational content is presented interactively to encourage participation and discussion.
- **Distance Learning:** Educational materials and online platforms facilitate both independent and synchronous learning.





## Program Calendar

The program runs for 8 semesters, with each semester including 3 core courses, excluding elective courses. The academic year consists of three semesters, with enrollment opportunities at the start of each semester. The entry points are twice per year ( Jan – Sept ) – Summer courses are optional and intensive

## Admission Requirements

- A bachelor's degree is required + A proof of the degree (transcript).
- Basic English language skills are necessary (students must pass Theological English Level 1 to continue the master degree- Students they have an equivalent certificate such as TOEFL or IELTS are supposed to be enrolled to the theological English )
- Proficiency in computer use and internet browsing, along with access to a personal device.
- A proof of Membership in a local church.
- A letter of recommendation from a pastor or spiritual leader.
- A minimum of 4 years as a believer.

## Registration Process

1. Submit an Online Application: Includes filling out the application form and answering personal questions.
2. Attend an Interview: An interview is scheduled after the correct submission of the required documents.
3. Notification of Results: Results are sent to applicants via email within two weeks of the interview.. correct the english and rephrase if needed.

## Tuition Fees :

- The total cost of the certificate is €3,000.
- Students can apply for a scholarship covering up to 90% of the certificate's cost, based on individual circumstances.
- The cost per academic hour is €50.
- Final project fees €100.

- **High School Diploma:** To receive accreditation, please submit a high school diploma.
